Old City Historic Walking Tour

A Day in Amish Country

Your tour starts with a journey to the idyllic countryside of Lancaster County, where you'll hear about the beginnings of Amish culture in the United States and see farmers hard at work in their fields. Your local guide will fully immerse you in the way of life here with a visit to an 1800s farmhouse, and your included admission to the Amish Village Museum will give you a deeper appreciation for the traditions and philosophies of the Amish communities. You'll have time for stops in small towns highlighting Amish-made goods, including quilt shops, bakeries, and roadside stands.

Visit 27 of Philadelphia's top attractions including the Liberty Bell, Elfreth's Alley Independence Hall and so much more on an one and a half hour loop. Private Walking Tour of Colonial Philadelphia

FROM PHILADELPHIA • TWO HOURS THIRTY MINUTES

A private walking tour gives you the opportunity to explore the birthplace of American democracy. This is a city rich in American history with plenty of mementoes of its British colonial past, including its iconic architecture. You will learn the origin stories of several of the oldest buildings in Philadelphia as well as visiting popular sites such as Independence Hall, Powel House, Jewellers Row, Liberty Bell and so much more. At each turn on the route, your guide will share stories of the old buildings, the preservation efforts, and the way the city tells its own founding story.



Best of Philadelphia Highlights Private Vehicle Tour

FROM PHILADELPHIA • THREE HOURS

Your private tour begins with an easy hotel pick-up in a private vehicle, from here your guide will take you on a poignant journey around the historic sites of the American Revolution. You will visit the homes of Benjamin Franklin and Betsy Ross, along with the homes of numerous other founders. You will also have a chance to see several of the city's other attractions, like the LOVE statue, Reading Terminal Market and Rodin's 'The Thinker' along with other public sculptures outside the Rodin Museum. You will also visit Philadelphia's Magic Gardens, which is an immersive mixed media art environment that is completely covered with mosaics.



Private Walking Tour: In the Footsteps of Founders

FROM PHILADELPHIA • EIGHT HOURS

On this walking tour of the storied Historic District, you will explore Philadelphia's historic district and learn not only its oft-told narrative but also the complexities of the nation. Learn about Philadelphia's role in the slave trade, its colonial past, and the development of trade links to claim its rightful place as one of the nation's most important centres of trade. Your tour ends at the entrance to Independence Hall, the site of the signing of the Declaration of Independence and the U.S. Constitution, in which you will participate in a tour run by park ranger Independence Hall guides.



Best Of Philadelphia Private Walking Tour

FROM PHILADELPHIA • THREE HOURS

There is nothing better than a privately guided walking tour to truly see a city and Philadelphia is no exception. From its role in inventing the United States to the modern ways in which Philadelphia continues to reinvent itself today, your guide will take you through the highlights and spots off the beaten track to give you a feel of the entire city. Visit Christ Church Burial Ground, where notable figures including Benjamin Franklin are buried, stroll the cobblestone roads of Independence Mall, see the Liberty Bell, Betsy Ross's house, and a Quaker meeting house. Explore Midtown Village and stroll 'Mural Mile' for some of the best graffiti culture in America, before ending at Reading Terminal Market.

Your tour will be packed with the history of the various neighbourhoods, facts about beer making, some food, and beer samples from each of the places you stop.



Pittsburgh Walking Ghost Tour

FROM PITTSBURGH • TWO HOURS

Discover Pittsburgh's historic landmarks—with a spooky twist. During this small-group, history-themed ghost tour, you'll explore the city by night listening to quirky and scary stories along the way. Highlights include Grant Street's parade route, Hollywood history at Allegheny County Juvenile Court, and the ghost of the Frick Building.



Fire In The Valley - Carnegie Steel & More

FROM PITTSBURGH • TWO HOURS

For those travellers who want to delve into the industrial history of Pittsburgh, this tour offers a much deeper experience than you'll get on a typical sightseeing tour. In the company of your guide, you'll visit such landmarks as the Bryce-Mesta Mansion Homestead, the 1892 Battle of Homestead Site and Braddock while learning all about Pittsburgh's Steel Valley.



Whiskey Walking Tour of Pittsburgh

Whiskey fanatics visiting Pittsburgh can look no further than this guided tasting tour showcasing the history of this famed American spirit. As you explore Downtown Pittsburgh, you hear about whiskey's role in the city's politics and social movements, learn about prohibition, and sample one of the oldest American whiskeys. With whiskey tastings and discount cocktails included, this guided outing is a great way to kick off your Pittsburgh experience.



Authentic Tour & Meal with the Amish

FROM LANCASTER • TWO HOURS

Learn about Amish culture in Pennsylvania's Lancaster County on this tour and dining experience. You'll explore the countryside to see historical landmarks and then meet a local Amish family for a sit-down home-cooked meal, where you'll have the chance to observe their way of life on a farm. The tour is designed by a local resident who grew up as a Mennonite outside Strasburg, Pennsylvania, and whose father was born Amish, so it is a true insight.



Amish Country Tour Including Amish Farm & House

FROM LANCASTER • THREE HOURS

Immerse yourself in the customs and traditions of Amish country during this three-part tour. Explore a farmhouse dating from 1805 where you will listen to the narrative on the customs, culture, and traditions of the Amish. You'll then enjoy a scenic ride through the Amish countryside, complete with photo opportunities. Then take a self-guided tour through a historic farmstead that includes a schoolhouse, a craft market, and a variety of farm animals.



Lancaster History & Craft Beer Walking Tour

FROM LANCASTER • TWO HOURS THIRTY MINUTES

Combine history and craft beer during this guided tour of Lancaster, ideal for first-time visitors. Learn about some of Lancaster's most popular landmarks such as the farmers market and the downtown theatre, before sampling some of the city's best craft beers alongside your guide. With a maximum group size of 12, you are sure of an intimate experience.



Food Tour of Downtown Lancaster

FROM LANCASTER • TWO HOURS

Discover the most interesting places to eat in Lancaster on this small-group food tour. Try a diverse mix of international flavours such as Danish, Cuban, French, Italian, and Ukrainian cuisine. Along the way, hear commentary about locals that you wouldn't discover if exploring alone, such as the stories of immigrants and refugees who moved to Lancaster to search for better lives and ended up launching local food businesses.



Gettysburg Battlefield Guided History Bus Tour

FROM GETTYSBURG • TWO HOURS

Visit sites from the Battle of Gettysburg on this guided bus tour. Your guide will share stories and tell you about the phases of the three-day battle, which was a turning point in the American Civil War. See Devil's Den, Little Round Top, the location of Pickett's charge and more. If you're a history or war buff, don't miss this chance to learn about a pivotal piece of the United States' past.



Haunted Secrets Of The Civil War Ghost Tour

FROM GETTYSBURG • ONE HOUR

The Battle of Gettysburg was one of the Civil War's most important moments, marking a turning point for a brutal war. Follow your host around town to several sights known for paranormal activity such as Unity Park, Dobbin House Tavern, and Gettysburg National Cemetery, and listen to accounts of the thousands of lives that were lost during this bloody war.



Foodie Tour Of Historic Downtown Gettysburg

FROM GETTYSBURG • THREE HOURS

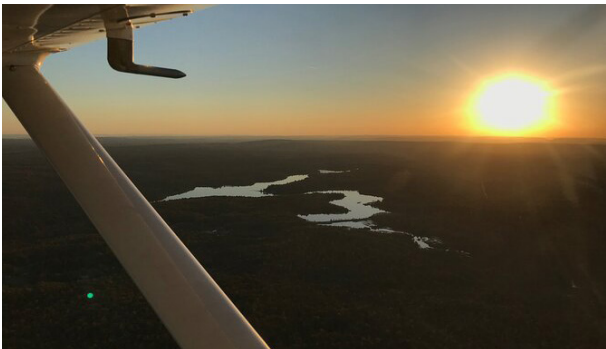
Set off on a delicious savoury walking tour of Gettysburg's best local haunts. On this tour, you'll sample local delicacies such as chocolates made from locally sourced ingredients and Pennsylvania Dutch pretzels. Investigate and sample why cheesesteaks are a favourite food among locals. You'll enjoy some of the region's best foods on this tour sure to satisfy food lovers and history buffs alike.



Private Mount Pocono Observation Air Tour

FROM TOBYHANNA (POCONO MNTN REGION) • TWELVE MINUTES

Get a rare, bird's eye view over the Poconos from above during this private sightseeing flight. Hop aboard a comfortable plane, with headsets provided for communication. Admire natural attractions like Great Wolf Water Park, Camelback Mountain, and the region's lakes from above, as well as local landmarks such as Mount Airy Casino and Camelback Resort.



Stock Car Ride-along At Pocono Raceway

FROM LONG POND (POCONO MNTN REGION) • THIRTY MINUTES

Ride shotgun along the famous Pocono Raceway in a 600-horsepower, NASCAR-style stock car. Select from a wide variety of starting times, then with a professional instructor behind the wheel, experience the power and speed of racing three laps up to 160 miles per hour. It's as close as possible to being in a real race. Racing suits and helmets are included.



Lower Yough Pennsylvania Classic White Water Tour

FROM OHIOPYLE (LAUREL HIGHLANDS) • FIVE HOURS

Go rafting on the Lower Yough for a thrilling outdoor experience in Ohiopyle. Located twelve minutes from Farmington and about one hour south of Pittsburgh, Ohiopyle State Park is home to the Youghiogheny River, which has class 2-4 rapids on this seven and a half mile trip. Your guide shares instructions on paddling and provides all the necessary gear. You'll stop about halfway for a picnic lunch on the river.
