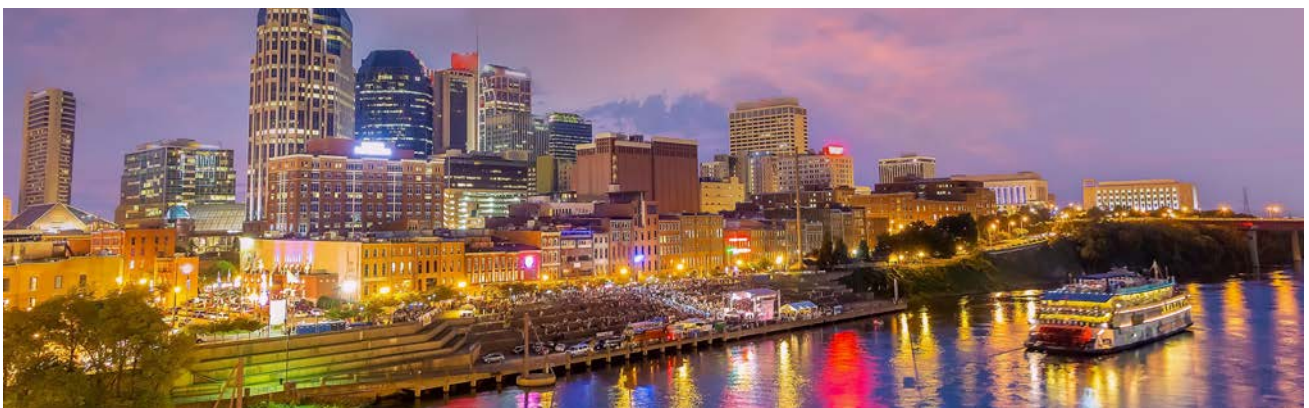

Grand Ole Opry

FROM NASHVILLE • MULTIPLE SHOW DURATIONS

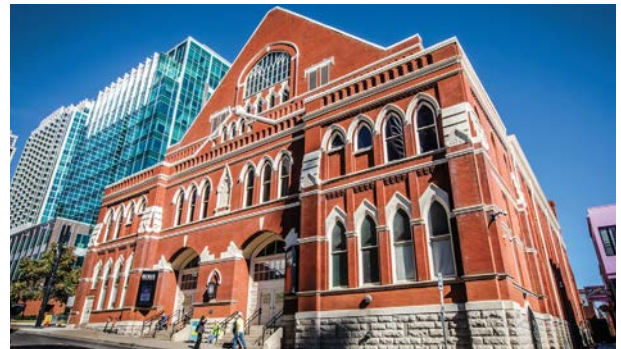
Dedicated to honouring country music's rich history and dynamic present, the Grand Ole Opry showcases a mix of country legends and contemporary chart-toppers who have followed in their footsteps. Featuring a dynamic lineup of eight or more artists on each show, see why the Grand Ole Opry is "the show that made country music famous." Unlike a typical concert, the Opry gives the audience a sample of several artists' musical styles. For an extra special experience, backstage tours are also available. Transportation is not included.



Ryman Auditorium

FROM NASHVILLE • TWO HOURS

Experience more than 130 years of musical inspiration in this storied downtown landmark and working venue, where the stage has a million stories to tell. Take a self-guided tour that starts with the soul of Nashville theatre experience before exploring star-studded multimedia exhibits throughout the venue. Alternatively, take a guided trip behind the scenes and get to hear what makes this auditorium music's most iconic stage. Transportation to the venue is not included.



Nashville Attractions Pass

FROM NASHVILLE • VALID FOR THREE DAYS

The Nashville Attractions Pass permits you access to the top tourist attractions in Nashville: National Museum of African American Music, Country Music Hall of Fame, Studio B Tour, Ryman Auditorium Self-Guided Tour and Grand Ole Opry House Daytime Backstage Tour. It is valid for use over three days (one entry per attraction per person) and allows you to visit each attraction at your own pace. Please note that some entry times must be reserved in advance. Transportation to and between each attraction is not included.



Nashville Trolley Tour

FROM NASHVILLE • DAY TICKET

Hop aboard the Old Town Trolley. More than just a sightseeing tour, it is a fun and educational adventure as your trolley conductor provides an entertaining narration that includes little-known facts and behind-the-scenes tips. You'll be passing numerous historic and tourist sites, such as the Country Music Hall of Fame, Ryman Auditorium, Music City Walk of Fame, Nashville Farmers Market, Centennial Park, Music Row and much more. Transportation to the meeting point is not included.



BBQ, Beer & Bourbon Food Tour

Learn the stories behind some of Nashville's most popular BBQ joints and drinking destinations! You'll go behind the scenes to get a taste of the best of the Music City on this food tour. This tasting experience will have you immersing yourself in Tennessee whiskey traditions at Nashville Barrel Co. with a tour and tasting. Your tour also includes a distillery tour and tasting, and a beer flight with local BBQ. Transportation to the meeting point is not included.



Fat Tire E-Bike Ride

Say 'howdy' to Music City on this rockin' tour of Nashville. Hop on your fat tire electronic bicycle and roll through some of the coolest spots the city has to offer, including Music Row, Printers Alley, The Gulch, and Fort Nashboro. There are lots of photo opportunities to be had with panoramic skyline views and unique local hot spots. Transportation to the meeting point is not included.



General Jackson Country Music Dinner Cruise

FROM NASHVILLE • THREE HOURS

Combining wonderful scenery with traditional Deep South experiences. As you cruise on the Cumberland River, you'll enjoy a delicious meal of local Southern cuisine while listening to the Country Music that put Nashville on the map. Don't forget to take numerous photos of the incredible Nashville skyline during your time on the cruise. Transportation to the meeting point is not included.



Guided Segway Tour

FROM NASHVILLE • ONE HOUR

See more of Nashville in less time on a downtown Segway tour. This is a great way for first-time visitors to orient themselves. You'll have time to master the basic techniques of your self-balancing Segway before setting off to explore the city. Tick off landmarks like the Country Music Hall of Fame, the Tennessee State Capitol, and the Schermerhorn Symphony Centre. Transportation to the meeting point is not included.



Jack Daniel's Tour

FROM NASHVILLE • SEVEN HOURS

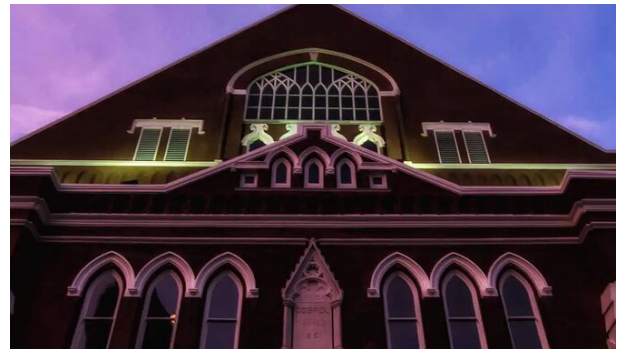
Travel from Nashville to Lynchburg to learn about Jack Daniel - his back-story and his world-famous Tennessee whiskey. You'll enjoy a premium tasting of Jack Daniel's single barrel, barrel proof, and other high-end whiskeys, plus a souvenir glass to take home. This tour also includes a visit to Jack's gravesite, not normally available to the public, for a special salute, as well as a reservation at Angel's Share.



Murder in Music City, Ghost Walking Tour

FROM NASHVILLE • ONE HOUR THIRTY MINUTES

This spooky tour is ideally suited for true crime aficionados. Experience a history-filled, evening walking tour, delving deep into Nashville's brutal past of mobs, murders, hauntings, and brothels. Learn the hidden history of the Tennessee State Capitol, listen to stories of Nashville's Red-Light District at the Hard Rock Cafe, and visit the iconic Ernest Tubbs Record Shop which was once a Civil War-era hospital. Transportation to the meeting point is not included.



Music City Bites & Sites: Food and History Walking Tour

FROM NASHVILLE • THREE HOURS

Explore downtown Nashville on a three hour walking tour. Learn about the architecture, history, and landmarks of the city, accompanied by a guide, as you wander through the historic riverfront area and sample Southern food items and a speciality cocktail. Transportation to the meeting point is not included.



Green Brier Distillery Experiences

FROM NASHVILLE • VARIOUS DURATIONS

Choose from three different experiences. The Tasting Experience provides an interactive and guided demonstration of the distillery's history and production process, followed by four tastings. The Distillery Tour takes you through the past, present and future of the distillery, plus premium tastings of four seasonal offerings. The Cocktail Experience begins with an overview of the distillery history and concludes with a lesson from a mixologist. Each option is around 45 minutes. Transportation to the distillery is not included.



Nashville Mural Tours

FROM NASHVILLE • THREE HOURS

Nashville has a huge array of murals, varying in style and content but all fun and vibrant. Choose between a morning or an afternoon mural tour of Nashville. You can either kickstart your day diving into Nashville's hippest neighbourhoods, seeing popular murals and rooftop views while enjoying mimosas and small bites. Alternatively, spend the afternoon sightseeing in Nashville's most iconic neighbourhoods, taking photos at Instagram-worthy murals, sipping on margaritas and taking in rooftop views. Transportation to the meeting point is not included.



Country Music Hall of Fame Museum & Studio B Tour

FROM NASHVILLE • VARIOUS DURATIONS

The Country Music Hall of Fame has a collection of over 2.5 million historic objects on two vast floors, devoted to Country Music. You will follow the evolution of the genre in the context of American History (Americana). Artefacts and exhibits have been carefully chosen and displayed from artists such as Johnny Cash, Dolly Parton, Garth Brooks and Taylor Swift. In addition, you will visit RCA Studio B, which is where artists such as Elvis Presley, Willie Nelson, Chet Atkins and others recorded and is still an active studio. This package is an admission ticket to the museum and a tour of Studio B. Transportation to the venue is not included.



National Museum of African American Music Admission

FROM NASHVILLE • TWO HOURS

This is the only museum dedicated to preserving and celebrating the many music genres created, influenced and inspired by African Americans. The museum's expertly-curated collections share the story of the American soundtrack by integrating history and interactive technology to bring the musical icons of the past into the present. Admission only. Transportation to the venue is not included.



Back Country Guided SXS Ride

FROM FRANKLIN • FOUR HOURS

Experience Tennessee's backcountry on a thrilling ride. This half-day tour is a great way to explore the rugged terrain of Williamsport in a unique way. Traverse dirt roads and shallow creeks, pass ghost towns and historic stores, and see caves and waterfalls throughout your journey. This tour departs from Williamsport, which is around thirty minutes from Franklin. Transportation to the meeting point is not included.



Sun Studio Tour

FROM MEMPHIS • ONE HOUR

Sun Studio was the recording studio to some of American music greatest artists such as Elvis Presley and Jerry Lee Lewis, and is still an active studio today. This tour takes you back to the conception of various unique American genres recorded here - from Rockabilly to Rock n' Roll, and later Country music. Your tour ends at the exact recording studio where the greats performed and recorded some of their greatest masterpieces. Transportation to Sun Studio is not included.



National Civil Rights Museum

FROM MEMPHIS • VARIOUS DURATIONS

Housed in the former Lorraine Hotel where civil rights activist Martin Luther King, Jr. was assassinated, this museum traces the history of the Civil Rights Movement from the 17th Century to the present. This museum will leave you spellbound for days and leave you with a better understanding of the struggles and sacrifices African Americans have endured. Admission ticket only. Transportation to the museum is not included.



Beale Street Guided Walking Tour

FROM MEMPHIS • ONE HOUR

Follow in the footsteps of musical legends, such as Louis Armstrong, Muddy Waters and B.B. King, on this walking tour of Beale Street in downtown Memphis. Your guide knows the ins and outs of the street, which is said to be where blues began, ensuring you won't miss a beat of its storied past. Pass by highlights including Lansky Brothers, where Elvis Presley was known to shop, as well as the more-than-100-year-old A. Schwab General Store. Transportation to the meeting point is not included.



Elvis City Tour

FROM MEMPHIS • TWO HOURS

Memphis is synonymous with Elvis and so many say that the two can't be separated. This tour takes you throughout Memphis, viewing the sites where Elvis hung out. Of course, the tour will also pass by other important locations where you may want to go later to further explore this rich musical city. Your guide is knowledgeable on most things Elvis, so be prepared to walk away knowing more about Elvis than you thought was possible! Transportation to the meeting point is not included.



Graceland Elvis Experience Tour with Airplanes

FROM MEMPHIS • FOUR HOURS

Whether an Elvis fan or not, this tour is a must for all those visiting Memphis! First you'll take a self-guided tour of Graceland, the famous home of the King of Rock 'n' Roll himself. Look through a plethora of memorabilia, like photos, personal mementos, costumes, and jewellery. Enjoy an audio tour of Graceland Mansion's exhibits that highlight Elvis' rise to stardom as well as the chance to visit the Elvis Presley Automobile Museum, featuring some of his favourite cars. Finally, you'll have chance to step on-board his two custom Airplanes, one of which named after his daughter Lisa Marie. Transportation to the meeting point is not included.



Graceland VIP Tour with Airplanes

FROM MEMPHIS • FOUR HOURS

The Graceland VIP Tour includes all the elements of the Graceland Elvis Experience Tour with Airplanes, however in addition, it also entitles you to front of the line mansion access, so there's no need to queue. It also gives you access to the exclusive Elvis in Hollywood VIP Exhibit and a Keepsake Backstage Pass. Transportation to the meeting point is not included.



Haunted Memphis Bus Tour

FROM MEMPHIS • ONE HOUR THIRTY MINUTES

Memphis has a uniquely dark history, filled with stories of ghosts, murders, legends, and lore. Explore the city's spooky areas during this haunted Memphis one and a half hour bus tour, and cover more ground than you would on just a walking tour. You'll meander through the city, making stops at the city's Victorian Village and downtown, as your guide tells you tales about Memphis that are sure to give you goosebumps. Transportation to the meeting point is not included.



Memphis Brew Bus

FROM MEMPHIS • THREE HOURS THIRTY MINUTES

Memphis might be best known for its music, but the city's burgeoning craft beer scene is equally worthy of attention. Get a behind-the-scenes look at three local brewers during this tasting tour. Sample the city's finest brews as you travel between locations in comfortable transportation. A private guide will be on hand to liven up the tour with fun-filled anecdotes. Transportation to the meeting point is not included.



Historic Walking Tour

FROM MEMPHIS • TWO HOURS

This walking tour of Memphis explores the city's rich history at a fun and leisurely pace. You'll explore Court Square, the lovely and historic heart of 19th century Memphis; enjoy sweeping views of the Mississippi River; and hear fascinating tales of rebels, cotton barons and bootleggers. You'll also experience a time-honoured Memphis tradition, the famous March of the Ducks at The Peabody Hotel. Transportation to the meeting point is not included.



Discovery Tour with Riverboat Cruise

FROM MEMPHIS • SIX HOURS

Discover Memphis' rich history, musical heritage, and Southern cuisine on this comprehensive tour. Take in all the highlights of downtown Memphis, from the Blues bars of Beale Street and historic Victorian mansions to the site where Martin Luther King Jr. was assassinated and one of Elvis' early apartments. Finish the tour with a delicious BBQ tasting and a scenic cruise on the Mississippi River. Transportation to the meeting point is not included.



Horseback Trail Ride Tour

FROM MEMPHIS • ONE HOUR

You don't have to retreat to the country to live your cowboy or cowgirl adventure: this 4,500 urban oasis is right in the middle of Memphis. Saddle up and explore the trails inside this sprawling city park, which is home to a variety of wildlife including deer, ducks and cranes. The horses are well-trained and accustomed to riders of all experience levels. Transportation to the meeting point is not included.



Memphis Pass

FROM MEMPHIS • VALID FOR THREE DAYS

The Memphis Pass allows you access to the top tourist attractions in Memphis. The pass is valid for three days (one visit per attraction per person), giving you ample time to go at your own pace. You can choose to visit all attractions on the pass or only a few. It includes admission to Graceland Elvis Experience, National Civil Rights Museum, Rock 'n Soul Museum, Stax Museum of American Soul Music and Sun Studio. Transportation to and between each attraction is not included.



Mojo Bus Tour

FROM MEMPHIS • ONE HOUR THIRTY MINUTES

Shake, rattle, and roll through Memphis on this guided musical bus tour. Local musicians lead the way on a fun-loving ride through the home of blues, complete with live music and tambourines, shakers, and bongos for all to enjoy. Visit historic Beale Street, one of the most iconic streets in America, plus Stax Studio, the Lorraine Motel, and more. You may choose to include admission with your tour to Sun Studio, the most famous recording studio in the world. Transportation to the meeting point is not included.



Taste of Downtown Memphis Food Tour

FROM MEMPHIS • THREE HOURS

Chow down like a true Memphian during this history-packed Memphis food tour. You'll enjoy seven specially prepared food tastings at six different hotspots, including both family-owned eateries and award-winning restaurants. Taste classic dishes from hot tamales to house-made desserts, many using only sustainable, locally sourced ingredients. You'll also discover the culture and history of this dynamic Tennessee city along the way. Transportation to the meeting point is not included.



Day Trip to Tupelo, Mississippi – Birthplace of Elvis Presley

FROM MEMPHIS • EIGHT HOURS

This tour is definitely one for Elvis aficionados as you will learn all about Elvis, from his childhood to his rise to fame and finally his tragic death. The two hour journey from Memphis to Tupelo, provides ample time for you to learn about the King from your guide. Once there, you'll visit various stomping grounds of Elvis, such as his birthplace, Tupelo Hardware, the diner where Elvis hung out and many more important locations from his life. Pick up available from downtown Memphis hotels.



Private Walking Tour of the Memphis Music Scene

FROM MEMPHIS • TWO HOURS THIRTY MINUTES

On your Private Tour of Beale Street, you'll learn the musical history of Memphis, the stars of the show, and their stories. You'll find out who W.C. Handy was and the influence that Sam Phillips had on the journey of rock n' roll, the blues, and the many famous musicians associated with these influential strains that have made Memphis famous for its music. Beale Street is in downtown and runs from the Mississippi River to East Street, a distance of nearly two miles. Your tour finishes with a drink at a local haunt, where your guide will give insight into the best place to indulge in Memphis's music scene. Pick up available from downtown Memphis hotels.



Private Walking Tour of Memphis with Graceland Tickets

FROM MEMPHIS • EIGHT HOURS

Famous for producing influential strains of blues and rock 'n' roll, Memphis played a huge role in Elvis Presley's success. A visit here wouldn't be complete without a day spent chasing down The King – from his childhood stomping ground to a skip-the-line visit to his world-famous Graceland. You'll see his boyhood home where he grew up, the Malco Theatre where Elvis had his first job, and the Peabody Hotel where he signed his contract with RCA. You'll wander down Beale Street and learn about the musicians who played there, before heading over to Graceland. Pick up from downtown Memphis hotels.



Private Walking Tour of Beale Street with Sun Studio

FROM MEMPHIS • THREE HOURS THIRTY MINUTES

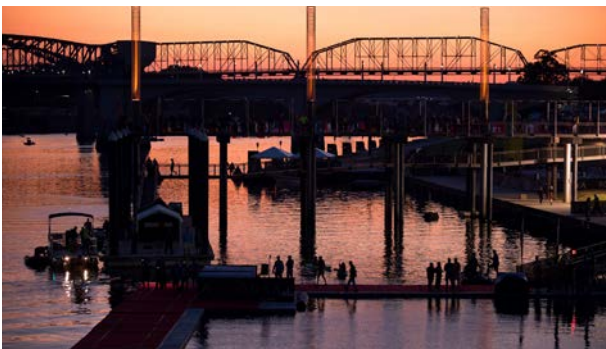
Stroll down Beale Street- a must-see attraction and one of the most famous streets in America. Your guide will point out to you the legends hidden in plain sight, including the Domino Lounge, Pee Wee's Saloon, and BB King's nightclub. You'll visit C Handy Park, which commemorates William Christopher Handy - a composer, musician and Father of the Blues. You'll also visit the legendary Peabody Hotel, famous for the march of the Peabody Ducks, and WDIA Radio Station which has been in operation since 1947. And finally, you'll visit Sun Studio for a small group tour. Pick up from downtown Memphis hotels.



ChattaBOOga Ghost Walk & Talk

FROM CHATTANOOGA • TWO HOURS

Walk the streets of one of the most haunted cities in the United States. Chattanooga is full of ghosts dating back to the Civil War days. Meet your spirit guide and discover its dark history. You may meet BuBu, the ghostly concierge of a haunted hotel, before making a visit to the former site of a blacksmith shop where they never stopped working. You'll also walk the ground of prehistoric man-eaters and see the mass grave site where dozens of lost souls are said to still roam. Transportation to the meeting point is not included.



Downtown Food Tour

FROM CHATTANOOGA • THREE HOURS

During this small-group, guided Chattanooga food tour, you'll discover top delicacies in the downtown district. Sample dishes at up to four curated dining locations, showcasing the wealth of options this city affords. You may also choose to include optional wine pairings. Transportation to the meeting point is not included.



Historic Downtown Chattanooga Segway Tour

FROM CHATTANOOGA • TWO HOURS

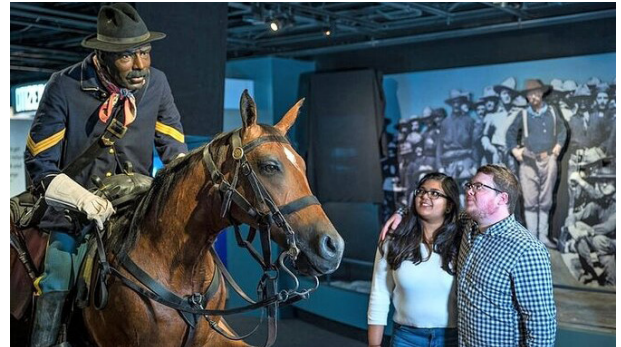
A Chattanooga Segway tour is an easy way to get to know the city's highlights in just a short amount of time. Glide through the city to top Chattanooga sights such as Miller Plaza, Tivoli Theatre and the Tennessee Aquarium. As you tour, your guide shares fascinating trivia and fun facts about Chattanooga's history and culture. Transportation to the meeting point is not included.



National Medal Of Honor Heritage Museum

FROM CHATTANOOGA • VARIOUS DURATIONS

One of Chattanooga's newest attractions, this admission ticket allows you to prebook your visit to the National Medal of Honor Heritage Museum before you arrive. This ticket is admission only, allowing you to flow through the exhibits at your own pace. To get the most from your visit, we recommend enjoying the short video on entering, which explains the importance of the National Medal of Honor. Transportation to the museum is not included.



Trolley Tour & Train Ride

FROM CHATTANOOGA • FOUR HOURS

This enjoyable tour focuses on the transportation heritage of Chattanooga - from the early days of horse cars through the train era that Chattanooga is famous for, and into the modern era of the automobile and the rise of the electric car. In addition to the transportation theme, you'll learn generally about Chattanooga's fabled history. As part of your journey, you'll experience a train ride on the Tennessee Valley Railroad. Transportation to the meeting point is not included.



White Water River Adventure

FROM CHATTANOOGA • THREE HOURS THIRTY MINUTES

The rushing waters of the Middle Ocoee River are your playground during this whitewater adventure. Climb into a kayak and paddle down the Middle Section of the Ocoee River through Chattanooga National Forest, accompanied by a guide. Those new to this adrenaline-filled sport will find the pre-launch orientation a useful tool, before you paddle through more than five miles of river. You'll encounter 270ft drops and crashing waves which will thrill even the most seasoned adventurer. Transportation to the meeting point is not included.



Foothills Parkway Smoky Mountain Tour

FROM PIGEON FORGE • TWO HOURS THIRTY MINUTES

This tour, taken aboard a pink jeep, showcases the breathtaking beauty of the Foothills Parkway, which is touted by many as the prettiest drive in America. You will view the Smoky Mountains' highest points and enjoy the scenic drive from Wears Valley to Townsend which is one of three gateways to Smoky Mountains National Park. Transportation to the departure location is not included.



Gatlinburg Loop Smoky Mountain Tour

FROM PIGEON FORGE • TWO HOURS THIRTY MINUTES

This jeep tour uncovers several of Gatlinburg's hidden gems. You'll begin with an informative drive through historic Gatlinburg and a photo stop at a scenic overlook. Next, you'll learn how the Great Smoky Mountains National Park came to be and why it is one of the most-visited national parks in the US with more than 13 million visitors every year. The tour ends with a narrated drive back to Pigeon Forge and a thrilling off-road trail. Transportation to the departure location is not included.



Newfound Gap Smoky Mountain Tour

FROM PIGEON FORGE • THREE HOURS

Newfound Gap's main attraction is its stunning viewpoint. It stretches as far as your imagination no matter the season. Ride in an iconic, open-air Pink Jeep and enjoy several stops near streams and lookouts for that perfect photo opportunity. Transportation to the departure location is not included.



Roaring Fork Smoky Mountain Tour

FROM PIGEON FORGE • THREE HOURS

Experience the Roaring Fork Motor Nature Trail from an open-air Pink Jeep Wrangler! Ride through thick forests, past roaring streams and cascading waterfalls on this Pigeon Forge to Smoky Mountains tour. The tour ends with a thrilling, 4x4 off-road adventure. Transportation to the departure location is not included.



Titanic Museum Admission

FROM PIGEON FORGE • VARIOUS DURATIONS

Relive the tragic sinking of the Titanic at the Titanic Museum in Pigeon Forge, which is a half-scale model of the original ship. Follow the fate of a real passenger as you explore the Titanic's cabins, suites, and exhibits. You'll see a real iceberg and artefacts which were taken from the ship. Transportation to the museum is not included.



Wine Me, Shine Me, Dine Me

FROM PIGEON FORGE • THREE HOURS FORTY FIVE MINUTES

Tennessee is known for its whiskey and moonshine, but sampling at distilleries is impossible for whoever has to do the driving. This Pigeon Forge wine, whiskey and moonshine tour mixes a bit of Appalachian culture with visits to two popular distilleries, without the need to drive and accompanied by a knowledgeable guide. Transportation to the downtown meeting point is not included.



Thundering Streams & Falls of the Smokies Hiking Tour

FROM GATLINBURG • THREE HOURS

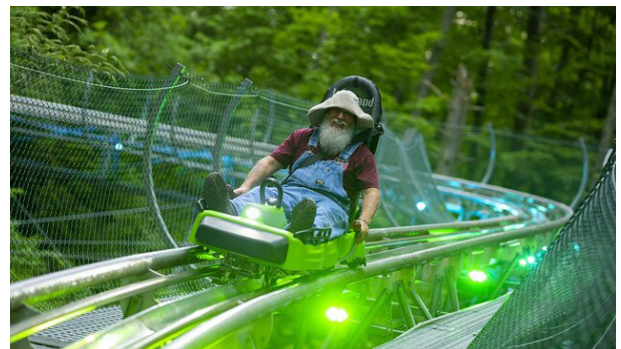
The Great Smoky Mountains boast some of the most scenic views in the whole of the USA. This guided hiking tour takes you on a journey to see them for yourself. You'll join a small group, traversing through the lush landscapes in search of bubbling streams, cascades, and creeks. Each season of the year puts on a different show for hikers, so there's always something to enjoy. Transportation to the meeting point is not included.



Moonshine Mountain Coaster Ride

FROM GATLINBURG • FIFTEEN MINUTES

Gatlinburg and the Smoky Mountains are beautiful places any time of year. The Moonshine Mountain Coaster is a unique, family-friendly thrill ride that puts you in the driver's seat. Race through the Smoky Mountains on a unique track with a brake system that puts you in control. And best of all, the tubular rails guarantee a smooth, comfortable ride every time! Transportation to the coaster is not included.



Ziplining at Sevierville Nature Park

FROM SEVIERVILLE • TWO HOURS

Adventure Park at Five Oaks offers the natural wonderland of the Great Smoky Mountains. Sitting in the heart of Sevierville, the 70-acre natural park takes you from the busy town to the beauty of nature in merely minutes. This experience is perfect for adrenaline seekers, as it zips you above the beautiful park whilst offering views of the Smoky Mountains. There are seven zip lines, which measure up to 2,000ft long! Transportation to the park is not included.



Ridge Runner Smoky Mountain Helicopter Tour

FROM SEVIERVILLE • FIFTEEN MINUTES

See the Smoky Mountains in their full, rolling glory on a 15 minute helicopter tour. Rise above historic downtown Sevierville and catch a glimpse of Pigeon Forge and Tennessee Valley from the air, before swooping over the majestic Chilhowee Mountain Range. You will enjoy a bird's-eye view of vast, undeveloped swaths of Smoky Mountain National Park, soaring just above the treetops and cresting over the sheer cliffs of Bluff Mountain and Sugarloaf Mountain. It's an unforgettable way to experience the beauty of one of America's great mountain ranges. Transportation to the meeting point is not included.
