Grand Canyon Helicopter Tours

FROM GRAND CANYON • MULTIPLE DURATIONS AVAILABLE

Antelope Canyon & Horseshoe Bend

All in one day, you can tour Antelope Canyon, Horseshoe Bend and the Navajo Nation. Experience one of the most picturesque slot canyons at Antelope Canyon, where incredible shapes form unbelievable waves of light. Next you'll take in the breathtaking views of Horseshoe Bend, one of the most pictured regions of Arizona. Your day includes a myriad of other American West special sights. Apache Trail, Lakes, Deserts & Mountains

FROM SCOTTSDALE • NINE HOURS

On this full day adventure, you'll explore the Apache Trail and the Superstition Mountains. The Apache Trail was Arizona's first designated "Historic Highway" and is also considered a scenic byway. The original Apache Trail was a footpath through the Superstition Mountains and now is one of the most scenic drives and best ways to experience the Sonoran Desert. Pick up from your Scottsdale hotel is included.



Colours & Canyons Helicopter & Minivan Combo

FROM SCOTTSDALE • THIRTEEN HOURS

Spend the day exploring the Grand Canyon State of Arizona, on a ground tour which includes the Grand Canyon South Rim and historic Route 66. Passing through Flagstaff, you'll see the San Francisco Peaks among the seemingly endless Ponderosa Pine forests, the largest contiguous forest of ponderosa pines in the world. As part of this full day, you also get to take an amazing helicopter flight over the Grand Canyon. Lasting 45 minutes, you'll soar above the deepest and widest part of the Canyon. Pick up from your Scottsdale hotel is included.



Sedona Highlights

FROM SCOTTSDALE • ELEVEN HOURS

Spend the day surrounded by the stunning red rock landscape of Sedona. This itinerary includes a visit to the Sinaguan Indian Ruins of Montezuma Castle National Monument, dating back around 1,000 years. Next, you will enjoy views of the famous red rock features of Bell Rock, Airport Mesa, and Chapel of the Holy Cross. You will also be treated to views of Cathedral Rock, Snoopy Rock, and Submarine Rock, to name but a few. In uptown Sedona, you can explore on foot the many art galleries and shops. Pick up from your Scottsdale hotel is included.



Tombstones Highlights & O.K. Corral

FROM SCOTTSDALE • TWELVE HOURS

Explore the “Town Too Tough To Die” and its classic western history during this Tombstone Tour. You'll get to stand on the sites of historic Old West gunfights, visit Big Nose Kate's Saloon, Bird Cage Theatre and the OK Corral. Other highlights include Tombstone Courthouse museum, Boothill Cemetery and historic San Xavier del Bac Spanish mission. Pick up from your Scottsdale hotel is included.



Verde Canyon Railroad, Jerome & Copper Museum

FROM SCOTTSDALE • TWELVE HOURS

This full day tour includes visits to the historic mining town of Jerome, the copper mining mecca of Clarksdale and the Arizona Copper Art Museum. After a morning of history and culture, it's all aboard the Verde Canyon Railroad. The unspoiled wilderness you will tour through is a scenic and historic treasure that has left people in awe since 1911. With stunning views of the Verde Valley from either your first-class seats or your open-air viewing car, the casual elegance of the train allows guests to discover the heritage of the landscape and its diverse ecosystem. Pick up from your Scottsdale hotel is included.



Canyoneering Adventure

FROM SCOTTSDALE • EIGHT HOURS

This canyoneering experience will take you places most people never get to go, deep into the red rock canyons outside Scottsdale. This day-long adventure takes you rappelling into pools of water, slipping down slides carved from the rock, and hiking short distances in the desert. Transportation to the meeting point is not included.



Hot Air Balloon Ride

FROM SCOTTSDALE • THREE HOURS

While in flight, soaring 2,000-5,000 feet in the air, the expansiveness of the Arizona Sonoran Desert is overwhelmingly humbling. In what feels so picturesque, the views almost feel unreal. In the distance, points of interest like downtown Phoenix, Camelback Mountain, Lake Pleasant, and State Farm Stadium (home to the Arizona Cardinals) are commonly seen, as the pilot shares the history of this fascinating city, and points out local wildlife and plant life. The balloon ride duration is 45-60 minutes. Pick up from your Scottsdale hotel is included.



Desert Guided E-Bike Tour

FROM SCOTTSDALE • TWO HOURS

If you've ever ridden an e-bike, you know how fun they can be. And if you're new to the sport, there's nowhere better to test the waters than the picturesque Arizona desert. Starting at the Sundial town centre, set out on an adventure with a local guide. You'll cruise through the desert, learn about local flora and fauna and get great photos and videos along the way. Transportation to the meeting point is not included.



Off-Road Tours

FROM SCOTTSDALE • TWO HOURS

If you're looking to ramp up the excitement of your Scottsdale adventure, look no further than this off-road tour. After the safety rundown, you and your guide will hop on your fully automatic ATV and hit the trail, winding through the diverse and beautiful landscape of the Sonoran Desert. This area features some of the most secluded off-roading trails in the Southwest, and rest assured—your guide knows all the best ones. Transportation to the meeting point is not included. UTV, Hummer & M1009 Blazer tours are also available.



Stargazing Tour with Night Vision

FROM SCOTTSDALE • TWO HOURS

In order to properly view the heavens, you need clear skies, darkness, high-powered telescope, and expertise — all of which are uniquely abundant when you're taken out to the Sonoran Desert for this awe-inspiring experience. Your guide for this tour is an expert astronomer experienced in helping you see many celestial wonders from the dark skies that only the Sonoran Desert can offer. Transportation to the meeting point is not included.



Old Town Scottsdale Food Tour

FROM SCOTTSDALE • THREE HOURS

Eat your way through Scottsdale's Old Town on a mouthwatering walking tour. Make sure to come hungry, as the two-mile route takes you to six different restaurants. Taste the eateries' top dishes and wash them down with cocktails and non-alcoholic drinks. This tour is the perfect introduction into Scottsdale's culinary scene. Transportation to the meeting point is not included.



Rappelling Adventure

FROM SCOTTSDALE • FOUR HOURS

This adventure is one for the memory books. Hike through the Sonoran Desert outside Scottsdale, to a local peak, before taking the exciting way down! Harness up, lean back, and enjoy the descent. In that moment, it's just you, the ropes, and the rock face. Your guide will ensure you are comfortable with the rappelling technique in a safety briefing before you set out. Transportation to the meeting point is not included.



Sunsets, Segways & City Lights

FROM SCOTTSDALE • TWO HOURS

Visit three iconic Scottsdale neighbourhoods and over 30 local points of interest during this group Segway tour. You will follow a seven mile route through the historic Old Town, the trendy arts district, and along the pretty waterfront. You could also choose to beat the heat on a sunset departure, enjoying evening views at the most photogenic time of the day. Transportation to the meeting point is not included.



Sonoran Desert Guided Mountain Bike Tour

FROM SCOTTSDALE • THREE HOURS

This mountain bike tour is an active and adventurous way to explore some of the Sonoran Desert's most impressive scenery. After getting acquainted with your mountain bike, grab your helmet and gear and head off into the desert, passing towering cacti and rolling mountains along the way. This tour offers multiple start times, from morning to afternoon. Transportation to the meeting point is not included.



Sonoran Desert Hiking Tour

FROM SCOTTSDALE • TWO HOURS

Spend some time exploring the Sonoran Desert on foot, with an experienced guide. You'll learn about the plants and animals of this incredible area while you hike through the rocky desert landscape. The hikes are designed to suit a variety of fitness levels and abilities and are customised to accommodate the needs of each group. Transportation to the meeting point is not included.



Secret Antelope Canyon & Horseshoe Bend Tour

FROM LAKE POWELL/PAGE • THREE HOURS

The shaded, open-air 4x4 tour truck takes you on a thrilling six mile off-road adventure to the entrance of Secret Antelope Canyon, followed by a 300-metre nature walk to the stunning slot canyon. Next, you'll visit Horseshoe Bend, where you'll avoid the congestion and take a private dirt road that leads to within 100 metres of the edge of the canyon. This exclusive access allows you to have a much shorter walk to the rim and enjoy breathtaking views of the Colorado River winding around the Horseshoe Bend loop. Transportation to the meeting point is not included.



Canyon Princess Dinner Cruise

FROM LAKE POWELL/PAGE • TWO HOURS

This beautiful dinner cruise combines spectacular Wahweap Bay scenery with a delicious dining experience and a breathtaking sunset over Lake Powell. The delightful menu is made up of salads, breads, a variety of entree options, and a choice of mouth-watering desserts. Transportation to the harbour is not included.



Antelope Canyon Kayak Tour

FROM LAKE POWELL/PAGE • TWO HOURS THIRTY MINUTES

Join a small group on a two and a half hour kayak tour, departing from Lake Powell with a destination of Antelope Canyon. With knowledgeable and experienced guides, you will paddle approximately two and a half miles until the water ends. At the end of the kayak tour, you'll have the chance to explore the breathtaking beauty of Antelope Canyon, renowned for its unique landscape. A further two hour hike is also available should you wish to extend the day. Transportation to the meeting point is not included.



Antelope Canyon Paddleboard Tour with Hike

FROM LAKE POWELL/PAGE • FOUR HOURS THIRTY MINUTES

Situated near Page, Arizona, on Navajo land, Antelope Canyon is a mesmerising natural slot canyon and a celebrated landmark in the American Southwest. Join a small group on this four and a half hour paddleboard tour from Lake Powell to Antelope Canyon. With knowledgeable and experienced guides, you will paddle approximately two and a half miles, from there you will hike through the beautiful slot canyon which is only accessible by water. Transportation to the meeting point is not included.



Horseshoe Bend Rafting Trip

FROM LAKE POWELL /PAGE • FOUR HOURS

On this incredible rafting adventure, you'll experience 10 miles of the Colorado River in just half a day. The trip begins in Page, where you board a bus and transfer over to Lee's Ferry. On arrival, your guide provides a quick orientation and shares plans for the day. Then sit back and relax as you take in the sights and stories of the Colorado River in Glen Canyon, including the rich natural and human history of the region. You'll make a beach stop, where you can take a short hike to see a petroglyph panel and even take a quick dip in the cool river. Back aboard your river raft, you'll float through iconic Horseshoe Bend. The day ends with a bus journey back to Page.



Lake Powell Boat Tours

FROM LAKE POWELL/PAGE • MULTIPLE DURATIONS

There's no better way to see the best of what Lake Powell has to offer, while learning about its history and geology than stepping aboard a boat tour. We have three guided experiences for you to choose from. Navajo Canyon Boat Tour is 3 hours, Scenic Dam Cruise is 90 minutes, and Rainbow Bridge Cruise is 7 hours. Whichever you choose you are assured of a wonderful tour, experiencing the beauty of nature and hearing about its history. Transportation to the meeting point is not included.



Lower Antelope Canyon Hiking Tour

FROM LAKE POWELL/PAGE • ONE HOUR THIRTY MINUTES

A short ten minute walk along Navajo sandstone brings you to the entrance to the Lower Canyon, where you start your one and a half hour experience, covering just over a mile. After descending down five flights of stairs (35 meters) you arrive at the largest cavern of the tour, and start the majestic ascent through the kaleidoscope of colours naturally provided by the unique creation of Navajo Sandstone - the result of rain, wind and erosion. Transportation to the meeting point is not included.



Stargazing Tour

FROM SEDONA • ONE HOUR TEN MINUTES

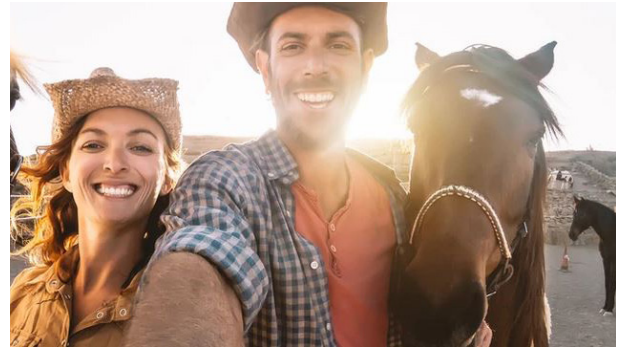
Join a small group on this Sedona astronomy experience. The tour includes an overview of the constellations in the night sky led by a professional astronomer who is using a high-power laser pointer. They'll tell you stories about how the ancient civilisations named the constellations and how they are used. You'll then be given an up-close view of a minimum of 6 celestial objects through one of the powerful telescopes. Transportation to the meeting point is not included.



Guided Horseriding Adventure

FROM SEDONA (COTTONWOOD) • ONE HOUR

Take a horseback ride through the breathtaking scenery of Arizona. From the stables in Cottonwood (30 minutes south of Sedona), your guide and small group set out on a tour through the Alcantara Vineyards. You'll cross the water where the Verde River and Oak Creek meet, get up close to ancient Apache ruins and admire panoramic mountain views during this scenic excursion. No prior experience is necessary. Transportation to the meeting point is not included.



Antelope Canyon & Horseshoe Bend Tour

FROM SEDONA • ELEVEN HOURS

Take a bucket-list adventure to Horseshoe Bend and Lower Antelope Canyon on this exciting day trip from Sedona. You'll see the Painted Desert and Navajo Nation, enjoy lunch at Glen Canyon Dam and shop at Cameron Trading Post. Antelope Canyon is the most visited, most photographed slot canyon in the American Southwest. At Horseshoe Bend, you'll take a one and a half mile hike to the Overlook for spectacular views. The mighty Colorado River cuts through Glen Canyon 1,100 feet below and unveils how the bend got its name. Pick up from Sedona hotels included.



Grand Canyon Premier Tour

FROM SEDONA • TEN HOURS

This Grand Canyon Premier Tour offers an unparalleled journey of style and comfort to view one of the Seven Wonders of the World. You'll pass through Oak Creek Canyon and historic Flagstaff en route. On arrival at the canyon, its vast expanse lies before you at Mather Point where the Colorado River and its tributaries reveal two billion geological years. Your expert guide will share theories, facts and legends that add to the allure of the vistas and structures. Your return trip will showcase the Arizona high country once more, as you head from the majestic splendour of the Grand Canyon back through the cool pines. Transportation to the meeting point is not included.



Ancient Ruin Jeep Tour

FROM SEDONA • THREE HOURS

This archaeological tour offers an up-close look at Sedona cliff dwellings and a time when the Sinagua people called this area home. Little is known about the customs of the Sinagua, who occupied the site for an estimated 200 years between A.D. 1150 and 1350. Painted pictographs, carved petroglyphs and ancient artefacts offer a glimpse into their lifestyle. You will learn about Sinagua's high desert farming techniques, far-reaching trade system and theories as to why they mysteriously vanished. Transportation to the meeting point is not included.



Broken Arrow Jeep Tour

FROM SEDONA • TWO HOURS

Buckle up and hold on tight for the Broken Arrow Tour, Sedona's most exclusive and thrilling off-road adventure! You'll climb over and atop the area's iconic red rocks, hold your breath down steep descents and enjoy stunning 360-degree views of Southwest wilderness. Majestic views and stunning photos await—panoramas of towering rock spires and unique geological formations surrounded by juniper and cypress. Transportation to the meeting point is not included.



Coyote Canyons Jeep Tour

FROM SEDONA • TWO HOURS

Sedona's remote canyons are just as stunning as its ascending trails. Discover their beauty on the Coyote Canyons Tour as you ride in an open-air jeep into Sedona's outback where wildlife, scenery and photo ops abound. You'll see and learn about the many iconic red-rock formations that Sedona is known for – Snoopy Rock, Coffee Pot Rock and Thunder Mountain to name a few. Transportation to the meeting point is not included.



Diamondback Gulch Jeep Tour

FROM SEDONA • THREE HOURS

This exhilarating Sedona off-road adventure is a rugged 4x4 outback journey into high desert terrain and steep grand arroyos. You'll get a glimpse of Arizona's ranching past, expansive views of Red Rock country and a thrilling descent into Diamondback Gulch. Transportation to the meeting point is not included.



Red Rock Range Jeep Tour

FROM SEDONA • TWO HOURS

If you want the best views of Sedona's iconic red rock formations combined with an easy going trail ride and knowledgeable local guide, the Red Rock Range Tour has it all. Spectacular scenery and panoramic views are in store during this popular adventure. There are no significant elevation changes on this tour, so it's easy to sit back for a relaxing ride. Native landscape, wildlife and geological history add to the allure of the extraordinary, sweeping sights. Transportation to the meeting point is not included.



Scenic Rim Jeep Tour

FROM SEDONA • TWO HOURS THIRTY MINUTES

Experience views that will leave you breathless during this incredible Scenic Rim adventure. You'll climb high in elevation on bumpy, rocky terrain and see wild backcountry scenes, all while a local guide ensures that you won't miss a thing. Transportation to the meeting point is not included.



Touch The Earth Jeep Tour

FROM SEDONA • TWO HOURS THIRTY MINUTES

The Touch the Earth Tour is an educational journey into the mystical beliefs and physical characteristics of vortices—meditative sites found around the world that are believed to offer heightened energy for physical, mental or spiritual well-being. There are only a few places in the world that can claim to be truly connected to the earth's energy. But once you understand the science behind natural vortex areas, you'll go home feeling peaceful, revitalised and ready to discover one in your own backyard. Transportation to the meeting point is not included.



Historic Bike Tour

FROM TUCSON • TWO HOURS FIFTEEN MINUTES

Explore Tucson's colourful history and discover fun facts about bank robbers and its early Spanish settlers on a guided bike tour through the city. The relaxed pace and varied terrain—from quiet avenues to bustling university bike lanes—offer plenty of opportunities to discover the area's unique architecture and colourful alleyways. Transportation to the meeting point is not included.



Guided Horseriding Adventure

FROM TUCSON • ONE OR TWO HOURS

Choose from a one hour or two hour guided horseback adventure, departing from Rancho De Los Cerros in the beautiful Catalina State Park, which sits within Coronado National Forest. During either tour you will be presented with amazing views of the Santa Catalina Mountains, so don't forget your cameras. Suitable horses are available for novice through to more advanced riders. Transportation to the meeting point is not included.



Hot Air Balloon Ride

FROM TUCSON • THREE HOURS THIRTY MINUTES

On this incredible bucket list experience, you will soar thousands of feet in the air for a great overview of the valley, as well as low enough to just skim over the trees and cacti scattering the ground below. Your trusty pilot will provide a narrative on the history of the land below, point out landmarks, as well as educate you on plant life and desert flora. When your feet are firmly planted back on the ground, the bubbly is popped and chilled champagne is served for a balloonist's ceremony, a tradition dating back hundreds of years. Transportation to Marana Airport is not included. Please note the balloon ride duration is one hour.



Rock Climbing Or Canyoneering

FROM TUCSON • THREE HOURS

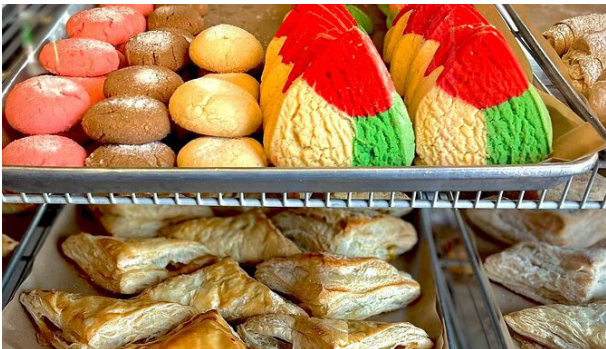

Highlights include rock climbing, rappelling down waterfalls, and improving skills if you're already an accomplished climber or canyoneer. All gear is included, and safety inspected. Specialist insurance is required. Transportation to the meeting point is not included.



Walking Food Tour

During this one hour tour, you'll be guided by an Old Tucson historian and have the chance to explore the famous movie set, learning about its rich history along the way. Legends of the Wild West at Old Tucson brings to life Calamity Jane, Billy the Kid, Wild Bill Hickock, and Jesse James through the magic of live entertainment. Arizona Route 66 Museum

FROM KINGMAN • DAY TICKET

The Arizona Route 66 Museum is located in Kingman's Historic Powerhouse and depicts the historical evolution of travel along the 35th parallel that became Route 66. In the Museum you can view displays from photos to life-sized dioramas depicting this road which was so important in its day. The story begins with early trade routes and the Beale Wagon Road, which enabled pioneers to cross the land in prairie schooners. An old Chevrolet truck and quotations from John Steinbeck's *Grapes of Wrath* help you understand the tough times along Route 66 during the Great Depression of the 1930s. Entrance ticket only.
